8. 프로그램 참가자 선정 절차

- 신청자 중, 상위학위과정, 학점, 영어성적 등 선발기준에 따라 1순위, 2순위를 정하여 실시기관(Tokyo Tech.)에 추천(실시기관(Tokyo Tech.)에서 최종선정하여 통보('21.1월 예정))

2021 AOTULE Summer Student Exchange Program at Tokyo Tech.

The Engineering School of Tokyo Institute of Technology (Tokyo Tech) wishes to invite students from the AOTULE(ASIA-OCEANIA TOP UNIVERSITY LEAGUE ON ENGINEERING) member universities to participate in the 2021 AOTULE Summer Student Exchange Program at Tokyo Tech.

Hereunder is a brief outline of the program

Participants: 2 post graduate students who are recommended by the home institution
(select 1st choice nominee, and consider selecting the 2nd choice nominee if funds are available)

Exchange Period:

June to August. Students must arrive at designated dormitory in Tokyo area on 1 June 2021 and leave on 31 August 2021..

During the exchange period, students may not leave Japan unless for emergencies such as health/family issues. Those who plan to attend any international conference held outside Japan during above exchange period are not eligible to apply for this program.

* Considering the unpredictable spread of the COVID-19 next year, please kindly note that the program may have to be shortened, postponed, or totally cancelled.

Activities:

In addition to conducting a research project, students are requested to participate in designated course work(s). Also, a two-day-12th Multidisciplinary International Student Workshop (MISW2021) is scheduled for the participants to present their work (either the research at Tokyo Tech or the one at their home institution) as well as presenting their home institution to other students.

Flight and Accommodation:

KAIST supports to purchase their air tickets to/from Japan and students are required to notify the flight details to Tokyo Tech. coordinator in advance.

Students must stay designated dormitory sponsored by Tokyo Tech.

*Accommodation is provided for the exchange students only. Tokyo Tech cannot provide/help finding accommodation for the student to visit with his/her family or others. It is possible that the students are accommodated with double rooms.

Tuition Fee and Allowance:

Tuition fees for the program are waived. Daily allowance is provided by Tokyo Tech.

*Amount to be determined in due course. For your reference, JPY 2,000/day in 2019.

Student Visa:

All students, including those from visa waiver countries, are required to apply for and obtain a 'Student visa' immediately after receiving acceptance notification from this program.

Insurance:

It is mandatory for all exchange students to enroll in the Tokyo Tech on-campus accident/liability insurance scheme and the students will be responsible for payment of its premium upon arrival. In addition, the students are required to join the National Health Insurance System of Japan. Purchasing a medical/Travel insurance for the duration of the program is also highly recommended in advance at home country.

How to apply:

Attach the application form, check list, academic transcript(from at least 2 years), english proficiency test score, copy of passport, certificate of enrollment, explanatory statement on expected graduation, and copy of visa to stay in the home institution's country(for int'l student) and submit it to Academic & Student Affairs Team for College of Engineering [by 13 November 2020](#) through the electronic official cooperation document.(school/department administrative team/office. * **Students need to submit the documents above to the department administrative team/office before the deadline.(check the department team/office submission deadline.)**

The Tokyo Tech AOTULE Committee will review the applications and notify you of the candidate selection by mid January 2021. The selected students will then need to complete an online application form and to submit necessary documents for admission into Tokyo Tech. by 31 January 2021.
